The Rise of Passive...

- Since February 1, 2013...
 - The number of participants in 401(k)-type plans has increased from around 63 million to around 80 million (est) in 2024.
 - The annual contributions of these savers has increased from around \$300 billion per year annually to around \$600 billion annually.
- As of 2023, "More than \$15 trillion in assets...are linked to the performance of the S&P 500 index in some way"




Large Cap Vs. Small Cap Valuation




Preferred Stock Redemption: a Slow Motion Reaction




